Division Three: Either one pass with credit and five subject passes or (ii) two passes with credit and three subject passes and (iii) a grade aggregate for the best six subjects not exceeding 44.

Division Four: Either (i) one pass with credit (Grade 6 or better), or (ii) at least two passes at Grade 7 or (iii) three passes at Grade 8.
