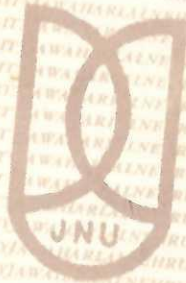

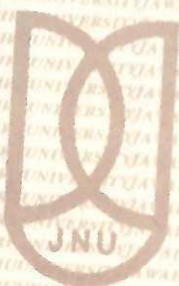

There is no rounding off either of the Semester Grade Point Average or cumulative Grade Point Average or Final Grade Point Average at the end of each successive semester as well as at the end of the programme.

The final grade point average obtained by the student shall be classified into following division :

*3.5 and above but less than 4.5	B-	Lower Second Class

* Student having cumulative index equal to or greater than 3.00 but less than 4.00 will be awarded B.A. (Pass) degree.
