



AWARD OF CERTIFICATE

Certificates awarded to successful candidates for the examination show (a) the name of the school (in case of school candidates) (b) all subjects in which the candidate has completed the course and which he has taken in the examination (c) attainment in all subjects taken (Grades 1-9, see below).

Attainment in a subject is indicated by a grade, of which Grade 1 is the highest and Grade 9 the lowest.

Subject Pass	—	Grades 7 and 8
Fail	—	Grade 9

CLASSIFICATION OF SUCCESSFUL CANDIDATES

Successful candidates for the Kenya Certificate of Education are classified as follows:

Division One: (i) Five passes with credit including a language subject from Group I or III and one other subject pass with (ii) passes in at least one subject from Group II, one subject from Group IV and one subject from Group V and (iii) a grade aggregate for the best six subjects not exceeding 23.

Division Two: (i) Four passes with credit and two subject passes including a language subject from either Group I or III with (ii) a grade aggregate for the best six subjects not exceeding 33.

Division Three: Either one pass with credit and five subject passes or (ii) two passes with credit and three subject passes and (iii) a grade aggregate for the best six subjects not exceeding 44.

Division Four: Either (i) one pass with Credit (Grade 6 or higher), or (ii) at least two passes at Grade 7 or (iii) three passes at Grade 8.

The word SUPPLEMENTARY on the front of the certificate indicates that the candidate sat for the examination on a second or subsequent occasion.
